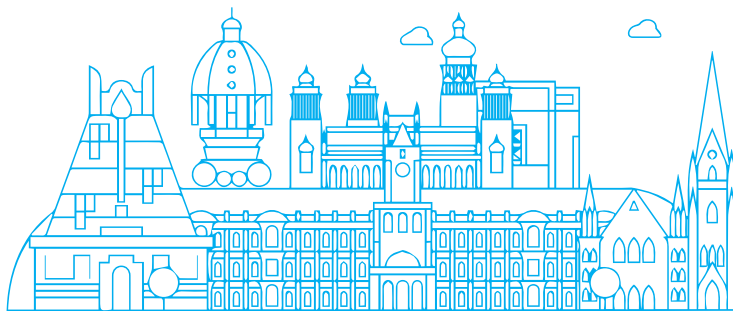

Time to adjuvant chemotherapy & impact on survival in advanced ovarian malignancies 3. Extent of peritoneal disease in lower abdomen and it's relation to nodal disease in stage 3c epithelial ovarian cancer. 4. CRS and HIPEC in stage III EOC comparison of oncological outcomes with CRS + IV and CRS+ IP chemotherapy 5. Rectal resection does not increase the major morbidity in patients undergoing CRS & hipec for colorectal pm 6. 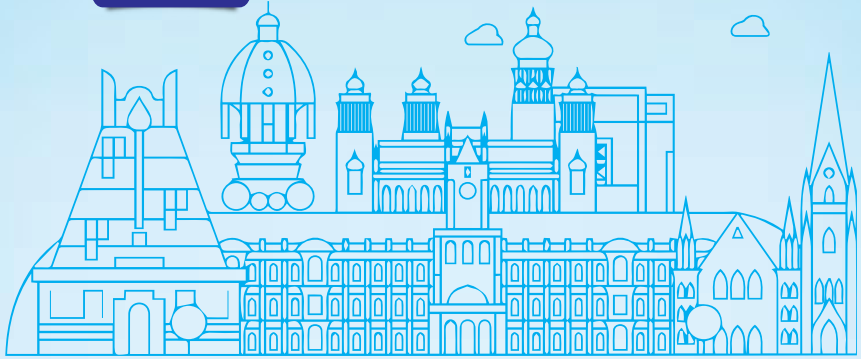
