Instructions and Guidelines for Stall Participation

1. Stall Concept Focus

Each stall must focus on one of the following themes:

- Substance Abuse Prevention (Tobacco & Alcohol)
- Diet and Nutrition
- Physical Inactivity & Exercise Promotion
- Personal Hygiene
- Clean Environment & Healthy Community

2. Eligibility and Submission

- Stall concepts must be submitted by a team from any institution or organization.
- Concepts should be experiential, innovative, interactive, and preferably activity- or demonstration-based.
- A panel of experts in the respective focus areas will review and shortlist the concepts.
- Judging will be purely merit-based; there is no fee or cost involved.

3. Concept Approval and Modification

- If a concept is strong but requires refinement in its presentation format, the committee may request specific modifications.
- Only pre-approved concepts can be displayed at the event.
- Any deviations from the approved version may not be permitted.

4. Stall Design and Setup

- Each stall must be eco-friendly, using reusable or recyclable materials.
- The stall size is 8 ft \times 8 ft.
- All stalls must be fully installed by the night before the event.
- A committee will inspect each stall prior to the event to ensure adherence to guidelines.

5. Stall Operation

- Stalls must remain open and functional from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM on all three days.
- Only two representatives per stall per day will be permitted.
- Representatives will receive **refreshments and lunch** on a token basis from the organizing committee.

6. Restrictions

- No sample distribution (food, products, giveaways, etc.) is allowed.
- No brand or product promotion or commercial activity is permitted. Concepts showing any commercial interest will be rejected.
- All volunteers, participants, conveners, speakers, event managers, and contributors must strictly avoid:
 - o Tobacco use
 - o Alcohol consumption
 - o Junk food within 500 meters of the event venue during the event.
 - o Institutions are responsible for ensuring adherence by their delegates.

7. Certificates and Awards

- All approved teams will receive participation certificates at the end of the event.
- Each day, visitors will vote for the Best Stall of the Day, and the overall winners will be awarded on the final day.

8. Submission Deadline

• Only stall concept notes submitted **on or before 18th January 2026** will be considered.
